Pursuant to the Provisions contained in Section 9, Ordinance 104.

10.—Whether Deceased has left any Property, and of what kind.

Movable & Immovable property as per Inventory

If the Deceased is not a married Person, or not married in community of Goods, or has left no Will,—this Notice must be made within *Six Days* after the Death.
If otherwise, it must be made within *Six Weeks*.

* * It must be filled up and signed by the nearest Relative or Connection of the Deceased who shall at the time be at or near the place of death,—or in the absence of such near Relative or Connection, by the person who shall have the chief charge of the House in or the place on which the death shall occur, and must be sent either to the Master in Cape Town or to the Resident Magistrate of the District, if within *Six Hours' distance*; if at a greater distance, it must be forwarded to the Field-cornet of the District.
